I. Appeals Cases

In the matter of 20 APP 11, 20 APP 16, and 20 APP 18 (*Knoob v. the City of Carbondale*), Counsel Haymaker indicated there was no new facts or evidence presented in the Petition for Rehearing.

The Commission agreed to vote on a MOTION TO DENY a Petition for Rehearing, based on the lack of new evidence or facts, in open session.

Related to *Hub Sports Bar v. the City of Champagne* (20 APP 14), Counsel Haymaker presented the summation of the facts pertaining to the case. After brief deliberation, the Commission agreed to affirm the local's but admonish them for the issuance and renewal of an incorrect license. They agreed to vote on the motion in open session.

In the case of 19 APP 18 (*John Simms v. Peoria, IL*), Counsel Haymaker, with the ILCC Legal Division, presented the background on the case and the fact patterns associated with the local hearing.

The Commission agreed to vote on a MOTION TO AFFIRM the local's decision in Open Meetings.

II. Adjournment

A motion was made by Commissioner O'Connell and seconded by Commissioner Gibbons to move into Open Session. The motion passed unanimously.
