I. Appeals

The Commission heard the PETITION FOR REHEARING filed in the matter of 22 APP 04 (*2635 Wabash v. Lynwood*) and since there was no new evidence or facts presented, agreed to vote on a motion to DENY THE PETITION in open session.

A summation of the hearing pertaining to 22 APP 08 (*Bobby McBride d/b/a/ Hollywood Lounge v. Murphysboro*) was presented by Counsel Haymaker. A decision was made to DISMISS the cases was agreed to be voted upon in open session.

A PETITION FOR REHEARING was presented before the Commission in the case of 22 APP 14 (*Anjani Cal City Liquors & Food, Inc. v. Calumet*). Counsel Haymaker informed that Commission that there are no new facts or evidence within the petition. Based on this fact, the Commission elected to DENY THE PETITION FOR REHREAINING in open session.

In the matter of 22 APP 15 (*Blo Room, Inc. v. Berwyn*) the Commission made a decision to vote on a MOTION TO DISMISS the case in open session, after hearing the facts and a summation of the hearing.
