

WHAT IS A STANDARD DRINK?

12 fl oz of regular beer

8-10 fl oz of malt liquor or flavored malt beverages such as hard seltzer (shown in a 12 oz glass)

5 fl oz of table wine

3-4 fl oz of fortified wine (such as sherry or port; 3.5 oz shown)



about 5% alcohol



about 7% alcohol



about 12% alcohol



about 17% alcohol

2-3 fl oz of cordial, liqueur, or aperitif (2.5 oz shown)



1.5 fl oz of brandy or cognac (a single jigger or shot)



about 40% alcohol

1.5 fl oz shot of distilled spirits (gin, rum, tequila, vodka, whiskey, etc)



about 40% alcohol

Each drink shown above contains 0.6 fluid ounces of "pure" ethanol and represent one U.S. "standard drink" or "alcoholic drink equivalent"
